## College of Arts, Social Sciences, and Celtic Studies International Postgraduate Merit Scholarships, Entry September 2024 Terms and Conditions

- 1. In order to accept the Scholarship, you have been offered, you must complete the online Scholarship Form within the specified timeline. If we do not receive a response, we will consider that the candidate does not wish to accept the scholarship. The scholarship will subsequently be allocated to the next ranked candidate.
- 2. Our Scholarships are awarded in the form of a partial tuition fee waiver. Should you require a scholarship letter, this can be provided and will be available from the application portal (in the supporting documentation section).
- 3. The scholarship amount is deducted from the tuition fee applicable for Year 1 of the taught Master's programme for the Academic Year 2024/2025. This scholarship is a once-off partial tuition fee waiver, it is not a cash award, and no cash payment will be made by the University.
- 4. International Merit Scholarships are Non-EU Scholarships and are only open to candidates who are classified as Non-EU for tuition fee purposes. Candidates must be resident of a Non-EU country, must be a citizen of the country and resident in that country when applying.
- 5. The University of Galway's Fees Office will be updated in relation to the Scholarship award. Therefore, if the required amount of fees has been cleared in full and online registration is open, candidates can register as a student at the University of Galway.
- 6. If candidates have partially or fully paid their tuition fee, any surplus amount resulting from the award of the scholarship will be refunded to their Irish bank account (once they have registered as a student at the University of Galway and have opened their student bank account, the Fees Office will transfer the reimbursed amount to that bank account).
- 7. If a candidate is in receipt of a Scholarship, they must be attending the programme on a full-time basis.
- 8. The Scholarship is tenable only at the College of Arts, Social Sciences, and Celtic Studies, in respect of the programme for which it is offered. It may not be transferred to any other programme. The Scholarship is only available in the Academic Year for which it is offered. It may not be deferred.
- 9. The University reserves the right to withdraw, vary or amend any aspect of a Scholarship if it is found that an error or mistake has been made by the University.
- 10. Scholarship recipients will from time to time be called upon to participate in activities such as providing a testimonial/video/blog of their University of Galway experience or welcoming delegations of visits from their home country to the campus.
- 11. Please note that you cannot combine the International Postgraduate Merit scholarship with another scholarship award.
